HETHER you have sensitive skin or not, getting a facial during the rainy season can get tricky.

The skin is usually more prone to reactive break-outs during monsoon because of high humidity levels, dirt, pollution and perspiration getting logged into the pores of the skin.

Keeping in mind the season's demands, beauty and skincare brand Kaya has introduced the Purepore Clear Skin' ritual that aims at tackling acne-prone skin while protecting it from the muggy season. The facial is a seven step ritual that lasts 90 minutes, involving a lost of specially designed mask bost of specially designed masks but no massages. It starts with purifying the skin by cleansing it with an anti-oxidant tea blend. The next step is to apply a serum for five minutes to prepare it for extraction of comedones, commonly known as blackheads and whiteheads. This is followed by a 'desincrustation mask' that is applied for 10 minutes to soften
